more than 10 per cent.

The ratio of number of delegates in each House district, and I am reading this from the Fourth Report, to the population of such district shall be such that the largest ratio shall not exceed the smallest by more than 10 per cent. We emphasize the fact that we believe this point is so important that we hope that the Committee will reconsider its view as noted at Easton when it felt
