We would still have the elections in even years. This summarizes the reasons behind our recommendation.

THE CHAIRMAN: What effect does it have on the number of elections, total, between Federal and state?

DR. BARD: You would have your Congressional elections every two years anyway in even years. So that you would have one portion of the House and Senate elected at the time of your Congressional elections that are nonpresidential congressional elections and the other portion elected during a presidential election term.

In other words, this would cut down on the number to be voted upon at any particular time as we see it.

THE CHAIRMAN: I still don't follow your time. You had your Federal election in '65?
