

1 unconstitutional under other standards.

2 DR. BARD: The only reason the courts have been
3 dictating it in this area is because the Constitution
4 has not made the necessary provision. This is our very
5 point.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment?

7 MR. BOND: Mr. Chairman, I might state that I
8 am from a more populous area. I have bone back and re-
9 read the Sections of the Third Report of the Legislative
10 Department, and the Second, and I see they vary as to their
11 percentages and I think there is a lot of good in what
12 Judge Adkins said, that we should not get into the matter
13 of how certain portions of the State should be represented
14 in the Legislature and the arguments/have been put forth
15 in this and the previous Report are not enough to convince
16 me to change my vote.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment? Dr. Bard,
18 in view of Mr. Miller's statement a moment ago, could
19 you indicate for the benefit of the Commission what the
20 views were of the Committee as to the percentage? I am
21 not sure I understood him, but I thought he said you were
