

1 DR. BARD: All right. We will change the
2 wording.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Is that the purpose of your
4 addendum as Mr. Case indicated?

5 DR. BARD: Yes.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question as to the
7 addendum?

8 DR. BARD: Shall we go to Section 6? If you
9 have your Constitutions handy, I would like for you to
10 turn to Page 18, Section 6 of Article 3, because there
11 is an important point which we are making here.

12 Section 6, The members of the Senate and the
13 members of the House of Delegates shall be elected by the
14 qualified voters of the legislative districts which
15 they represent, respectively, to serve for a term of four
16 years commencing on the third Wednesday of January next
17 following their election.

18 Please note that they don't serve from the
19 day of their election which our present Constitution says,
20 and which actually has not been operative anyway. We
21 went over this at Easton. We are now making it clear
