2 ing on the third Wednesday of January next following
3 their election.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Any questions?

5 MRS. FREEDLANDER: For the sake of conciseness,
6 I wonder if the Committee would accept this change that
7 the members of the General Assembly or of each House
8 shall be elected by the qualified voters instead of repeating
9 the words, members of the Senate and members of
10 the House. We agree the members of the General Assembly
11 shall be elected by the qualified voters of the legislative
12 districts which they represent.

13 DR. BARD: The reason why I think in this case,
14 Mrs. Freedlander, it might be better to name them both
15 because in so many States they do serve different terms.
16 Some of them/^{who}serve the House might serve a two-year
17 term, and the Senate a four-year term, and I think this
18 makes it clear from the very beginning.

19 MRS. FREEDLANDER: We say, to serve for a term
20 of four years.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: Wouldn't it be clear if you said,
