2 vote if it goes back up for reconsideration.

3 MR. GENTRY: Offsetting the work they will be
4 doing, they will be relieved of local matters, and there
5 wouldn't be any reason to carry it any further than 70.

6 MRS. BOTHE: We are going to be in continuous
7 session if we don't put this to rest. I voted with the
8 Committee and in the majority last time, but I intend
9 to vote for the proposed Section and against recon-
10 sideration this time. I think the arguments were fully
11 aired. While I voted with the Committee, I had some
12 thoughts. I think they were resolved after very thorough
13 debate in the last session to which nothing has been
14 added, and for that reason and others, I would certainly
15 not want to reconsider.

16 DR. BARD: Mr. Chairman, I want to say that
17 Congressman Miller's point is a new one. When we went
18 back, it was troublesome to us that we did not have
19 full faith in the Legislature. This concept whereby we
20 were going to let each branch have enough elbow room so
21 that it might handle decisions was not presented. This
