

1 fully an hour at Easton. I know of three members of the
2 Commission who were present at that time and not present
3 tonight who voted for the Report as it stands now and not
4 as the Committee would like to see it stand.. Two of
5 those three members have had a great deal of experience
6 in legislative matters and spoke rather eloquently and
7 forceably for their point of view and the point of view
8 that the Commission finally adopted.

9 Now, it just seems to me wrong to have the
10 Committee come back in here with the same thing again,
11 reopen the whole matter again, have it presented to the
12 Commission which is not full-staffed here tonight, and
13 I think the Commission should not reverse itself on
14 this, and if there is any intention of doing so, I think
15 a full poll should be taken of every member of the Com-
16 mission before any reversal of its stand is taken.

17 DR. BARD: This is a new position, Mr. Case.
18 The amendment which was made to the motion which I
19 accepted was never voted upon.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: I am sorry I didn't understand
21 that. Mr. Scanlan is accepting the amendment.
