

1 MR. CASE: Well, what is it?

2 MR. SCANLAN: I now move this, and as I under-
3 stood the parliamentary procedure, there was a motion
4 to reconsider what the Commission did at Easton on this
5 point of a continuing.

6 MR. CASE: That is what I am speaking to.

7 MR. SCANLAN: I would move to substitute for
8 that motion to reconsider a motion which would add the
9 following language at the next to the last sentence
10 of the present proposed Section 7, Comma, and must con-
11 vene the General Assembly in special session upon the
12 written request of a majority of the members of both
13 Houses thereof. That, I think, is certainly a new point,
14 and the mere fact you get new ideas as the Commission
15 progresses in its work shouldn't mean you are exposed
16 to the penalty that you voted on it at the previous meet-
17 ing and can't vote on something new.

18 I would hope when the final Report of the Com-
19 mission is presented to the full Commission, if enough mem-
20 bers of the Commission at that time feel that language
21 should be added, deleted, or changed, that it be done. But
