2 sion to act on the crisis, and I think if you adopt
3 this amendment imputes bad faith to a future Executive.
4 I also feel that we have the recommendations of the busi-
5 ness leaders, the Legislature leaders, and we have heard
6 all the arguments on this thing, and I think it would be
7 wrong for us when we have so many of our Commission
8 members absent to even adopt this amendment.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

11 get the view of the members of the Legislature as to
12 whether they would like the idea of having the privilege
13 of calling a special session through the procedure voted,
14 Mr. Bond.
