2 bated twice before at two previous meetings, but unlike  
3 the other action, the actions taken at the two previous  
4 meetings were not the same. The last session by a very  
5 narrow margin reversed the action of the previous ses-  
6 sion. You all understand the amendments, the several  
7 amendments, that is.

8 JUDGE ADKINS: Are we voting now on the  
9 amendment?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Voting now on the amendment  
11 of Section 7 to substitute for, both, and to strike the  
12 "s" on Houses in the fifth line, to strike the period at  
13 the end of the Section and add, and must convene the  
14 General Assembly in special session upon the written  
15 request of three-fifths of the members of each House  
16 thereof.

17 You ready for the question? All those in  
18 favor, signify by a show of hands. Contrary? The amend-  
19 ment is lost by a tie vote. So there is no question  
20 about it, a show of hands again, those in favor? Those  
21 opposed? The amendment is lost. Any further question
