2 venerable words of Article 10 of the Declaration of
3 Rights, where they say, or proceedings, where they say,
4 speech or debate.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Jim, what was the Article?

6 MR. GENTRY: Article 10.

7 DR. BARD: Or proceedings, are the words used
8 there.

9 MR. BROOKS: You say, speech, debate or pro-
10 ceedings.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: I would rather refer the ques-
12 tion back.

13 MR. SAYRE: How does that work in Congress?

14 MR. BROOKS: There is a constitutional pro-
15 vision not quite like this, giving legislative immunity
16 to Congress.

17 MR. MILLER: It has been held in the record
18 whether spoken or filed.

19 DR. WINSLOW: And includes committee reports?

20 MR. MILLER: Yes, and it is a very important
21 and sensitive thing. Very few legislators would have the
