means that half your Legislature is going to be elected at an election where the issues which are the subject of debate are national and not state issues. You will have no party platform presumably on which they could run. You have no statement of party principle because there will be no top candidate running. I can't see anything but what you are going to get, they refer to changes of sentiment, you may get changes of sentiment in local areas but it is difficult to see how you can get a change of sentiment in your Legislature when the issues which are before the people aren't going to be presented and debated in any consistent articulate manner.

The second problem I have, this is one that I at least would like to hear Governor Lane comment on, is it seems to me in every Legislature with every new Governor there is a shakedown period when each has to learn to live with the other. I suspect from having observed this scene fifteen or twenty years that takes two years before they each learn to live with the other. If you get a new Governor and half of a new Legislature
