2 THE CHAIRMAN: Or permit the Legislature to
3 waive the requirement by two-thirds or three-fifths.

4 MR. SCANLAN: That is right.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Which does the Committee sug-
6 gest?

7 DR. BARD: I would say waive it.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: All right, then, can we con-
9 sider Section 17 as recommitted for addition of appropri-
10 ate language providing for the waiver of the three-day
11 calendar rule, for appropriate vote?

12 MR. CASE: What is the disposition on the
13 introduction vis-a-vis printed controversy?

14 DR. BARD: Well, at present I would like to
15 suggest that it be amended to read, No bill shall
16 become a law unless it has been printed and upon the desk
17 of the members at least three days prior to final
18 passage. That would take care of what you have in mind
19 and also what Mrs. Bothe has in mind.
