you never had the whole House responsive to the people. You would always have half responsive to them four years ago, half currently. You would never get a responsive opinion in the House.

MR. CASE: Just as an addendum, as I understand the recommendation, you would never have one half of both Houses running with the Governor because there are four years and not six like the Senate. So those who -- if I am wrong about this, somebody should correctme.

THE CHAIRMAN: After the initial run, everybody would be elected for a term of four years, so the every other half could run --

MR. CASE: If you only had half, the half that held the seats which would be filled during the off periods would be four years, they would never come up with the Governor, would they?

THE CHAIRMAN: I see what you mean. If they continued to run for re-election, that is correct.

MR. CASE: They would be running with the Congressmen.
