

1 I could be wrong.

2 MR. MILLER: I don't think we ever planned
3 to put it in. I think we felt it belonged somewhere else.

4 MR. SCANLAN: Isn't it a fact that Sections 40,
5 40(a), and the others, (b) and (c), of Article 3, were
6 required because of the omission on the original Consti-
7 tution, in the Declaration of Rights or elsewhere, to
8 provide for a specific grant of the power of eminent
9 domain, such as now recommended by the Committee on
10 Declaration of Rights?

11 THE CHAIRMAN: I am not suggesting that we
12 necessarily must have the equipment of 40, 40(a), (b),
13 and (c), nor is Mr. Haile. All I am saying is, I don't
14 want all of the reports to ignore the existence of those
15 sections. It ought to be noted in one or the other of
16 the reports. Dr. Winslow?

17 DR. WINSLOW: Mr. Chairman, as I recall, the
18 Legislative Department Committee, there are still sections
19 in Article 3 which the Committee have not considered as
20 to whether they want to eliminate them or not. I do not
21 look upon the report of last night as a final report of
