

1 MR. SCANLAN: Would you accept the further
2 amendment? I still like answers to your national origin.
3 People have been discriminate^d against. Our Spanish-
4 American friends in Southern California wouldn't find
5 much protection to Mr. Haile's amendment.

6 MR. HAILE: I accept that.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Now, Dr. Jenkins, the amendment
8 which you have accepted, I take it, is after the first
9 sentence of Section 4 and before the second sentence
10 insert, No person shall by law be discriminated against
11 because of religion, race, color, ancestry or national
12 origin.

13 DR. JENKINS: Yes.

14 MR. GENTRY: Mr. Chairman, do you want to add
15 sex to this?

16 MR. SCANLAN: Would you clarify that a little
17 bit?

18 MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, if we vote on
19 this, will we get a chance to vote on the simple language
20 of Section 4 without the addition?

21 THE CHAIRMAN: I take it that if you prefer the
