4 DR. JENKINS: That impresses me. I will with-
5 draw this amendment.

6 DR. BURDETTE: What do you mean, original
7 proposal?

8 THE CHAIRMAN: The motion before us.

9 MRS. BOTHE: Could we hear it again?

10 THE CHAIRMAN: The motion before you is to
11 insert a sentence between the present two sentences of
12 Section 4, reading, No person shall by law be discriminated
13 against because of religion, race, color, ancestry or
14 national origin.

15 DR. BURDETTE: What does equal protection of
16 law mean?

17 MRS. BOTHE: The same thing.

18 MR. SCANLAN: Only more.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: I think we are going to repeat
20 all of the discussion. Let's not do that. Any further
21 discussion of the motion? Are you ready for the question?
