2 THE CHAIRMAN: Is that moved as an addition
3 to Section 6?

4 MR. SAYRE: I move that as an addition to
5 this Section, so you will have (a), (b), and (c) if you
6 count the first part as (a).

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second?

8 MRS. BOTHE: I will second.

9 MR. SAYRE: I think this is a compromise pro-
10 vision actually with respect to the privacy that I think
11 we are all entitled. I know there is sentiment widespread
12 that we should make any such violation of this privacy
13 a crime, and I would not say that that is out of line,
14 but his would be a compromise method, and I think that we
15 do permit even though a qualified search and seizure
16 process the tapping of your telephone or listening to an
17 electronic device without your knowledge, if we do that,
18 that this kind of power could be abused in another area
19 in our country; that we should not allow it constitution-
20 ally to be permitted.
