IV, compensation of members of the Legislature.

I think we can handle this one hurriedly, not to jam it down your throats. As you know, traditionally there has been a statement in regard to the alary of members of the Legislature. The Committee feels very strongly that there should not be any constitutional provision in regard to the salary of the Legislators.

On the other hand, we do feel that the particular Legislature should not be empowered to vote itself a raise in pay. Actually we feel that the present salaries are extremely inadequate and should be increased substantially. Accordingly, it recommends that compensation of members of the first Legislature after the adoption of the new constitution should be fixed by the constitutional convention itself, that thereafter the Legislature should be empowered to fix its own compensation but that any increase or decrease in annual salary allowances should not apply to the Legislature which enacted the same.
