

1 suggestion made by Mr. Miller, that the Committee was
2 considering, to eliminate the words, against him. Perhaps
3 not.

4 JUDGE ADKINS: I would suggest, Mr. Chairman,
5 that there have been two or three matters here that have
6 been discussed. Maybe the Committee might want to
7 reconsider some of this language.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: I think that might be desirable.
9 You made two suggestions, Mr. Claggett made a suggestion
10 involving changes in language, and perhaps the desirable
11 thing is to refer the Section back to the Committee to
12 consider these several suggestions.

13 PROFESSOR ASPER: I would like a little more
14 guidance if that is going to be the position, because
15 we have talked about whether, A person accused of crime,
16 is too narrow, whether we should include juveniles,
17 misdemeanors.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Let's get at it by a series of
19 votes to take the sense of the meeting on specific
20 matters without trying to agree on the precise language.

21 MR. MINDEL: I would like to include the
