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our recommendation in regard to compensation.

MR. HOFF: By allowances, you mean the word expenses generally?

DR. BARD: That is correct.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any discussion?

MR. SAYRE: I approve of everything here.

I would like to toss out for consideration an additional sentence that would have the effect of saying there shall be a mandatory review of the salaries of all state elective officials at least once every ten years.

THE CHAIRMAN: You mean that there be such provision in the constitution?

MR. SAYRE: I am thinking here that this might compel them, I was thinking to extend it beyond the elected officials to every statewide person who is paid, a mandatory provision that there be a review of salaries. This would have the effect of taking the onus off the Legislature of supposedly raising its pay.

THE CHAIRMAN: Let me suggest to you I don't think that would be properly a matter for this Committee. It is not limited to the Legislature.
