2 This question is almost certain to arise in the Convention,  
3 and I would hope that we would have done the research  
4 for it.

5 Any further discussion of the motion? Are  
6 you ready for the question? All in favor of requesting  
7 the Committee to make a study of the extent to which,  
8 if at all, provision should be made in this Section or  
9 elsewhere in the Declaration of Rights with respect to  
10 discovery procedures in criminal cases, signify by a  
11 show of hands. Contrary. The motion is carried, 11 to 5.

12 Are there any other questions anyone wants to  
13 have the Committee consider on the reference of this  
14 Section?

15 MR. MINDEL: Unanimous consent, Mr. Chairman.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: I am not sure I will phrase  
17 this the way you have it, Mr. Mindel. If not, correct me.

18 Mr. Mindel's suggestion is that the require-  
19 ment of Section 7 that there be a unanimous verdict of  
20 the jury in criminal cases be eliminated, so that it  
21 would be left to statute to determine.
