THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second? The motion failed for lack of second.

I would like to suggest, if the Chairman would be permitted to suggest, that the Committee in its report elaborate on the problems with respect to the language, have the assistance of counsel in his defense. At the present time, the report merely comments that this is broader than the present provisions, and since this is a subject that is likely to be the subject of a great deal of discussion and debate in the Constitutional Convention, I think it would be very helpful if our report could contain an elaboration and a discussion of the problems. Mr. Asper?

PROFESSOR ASPER: May I, in my own defense, say I have never really understood the comments we provided in these interim reports to the Commission are the final version of the comments.
