on the Constitutional Referendum. This is a matter which is dependent to some extent on whether we can get funds. We think we can. We have a good bit of the

man power that would be needed. We would still be trying very hard to get people to fill a few top positions.

But there is some prospect that we can do this also.

The top position is really one that for lack of a

better name we call editor, one who can take the research materials of this Commission and the various committees and turn them into public releases for consumption by

the general public and various other groups.

Part of this program involves obtaining for

this Commission six full time research assistants to work this summer. Five of these have already been selected, some of them are already working, several of them are here today. These are graduate students in political science or graduates of the law school, working only until Saptember but on a full time basis.

I will ask John to outline to you in a little
