substitute for it, but if you added the two words, by 1 law, that would apply to both the courts and to the 2 Legislature. 3 MR. MARTINEAU: This would go along with my 4 suggestion. 5 I would so move. MR. CLAGETT: 6

THE CHAIRMAN: I suggest to you, you don't meet Mr. Martineau's point. His point is that the Court of Appeals has said that any sentence imposed with the legislative sanction is not cruel and unusual, if it is imposed by law, it is imposed with legislative sanction; so it would not meet his point at all.

MR. MARTINEAU: Nor cruel and unusual punishment imposed by law.

MR. CLAGETT: Would obviate it at its inception.

MR. MARTINEAU: It would say that the Legislature, the law must comply with the requirement that the punishment which is imposed not be cruel and unusual.

THE CHAIRMAN: The Court of Appeals has already said that the law must not have cruel and unusual punish-
