an opinion not shared by other members of the Commission.

Mr. Asper?

PROFESSOR ASPER: Isn't it possible that we are going to have some other phrase than, cruel and unusual, to accomplish the purpose of this?

MR. MARTINEAU: Perhaps, excessive.

PROFESSOR ASPER: You have got, excessive fines imposed.

MR. MARTINEAU: Excessive fines; I don't know.
This is something I leave to your management.

MR. SCANLAN: That is something we don't want.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

MR. SAYRE: Just a question. Does this provision regarding bail make a person bailable?

PROFESSOR ASPER: Look at the comments.

MR. GENTRY: That is a new question.

THE CHAIRMAN: Not on this point. We haven't acted on this motion yet. Mr. Bond?

MR. BOND: I have one question on this point.
