At the meeting held on August 21, 1966, the Commission considered drafts of 18 sections of the new Constitution dealing with the Legislative Department as submitted in our Report. Some sections were approved as submitted. Others were revised and still others were referred back to us for further study, so this Sixth Report which you have with you will include action on the part of our subcommittee in terms of revisions that you submit as well as revisions noted here that took place as a result of the Commission recommendations at the

In this Report, the Committee on the Legislative Department presents drafts of those sections which were revised or referred back to us for revision. The Committee also submits comments on four sections of the present Constitution dealing with the Legislative Department, that is over and above what we reported last time.

There are sections that will be new in our commentery. Now, the first item of importance the Committee, in the sections it is resubmitting has placed all
