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a drop out part, that after a certain date it disappears. It is self-executing.

MR. SAYRE: If we did it the way I say it, you are still having enabling legislation that could be drafted to implement the schedule but not setting anything but a minimum. Is that not possible?

MR. MARTINEAU: You could set it within a variation. You could say not more than or shall not be less than.

To lead off with. Wouldn't that some of the onus off the Legislature in enacting its own? That's what I am trying to see if we can

DR. BARD: There are many possibilities. Here the Committee did not want to delineate the one possibility. Wanted to leave it broad enough so that this schedule could make it clear as to whether the Legislature were to do it or just how they were to do it. The alternative would be for the Legislature itself to actually do it. We felt that that would not be particularly good,
