

1 DR. BARD: Yes.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: -- be the same as existing
3 immediately prior to the beginning of that term.

4 DR. BARD: By constitution, you mean schedule?
5

6 THE CHAIRMAN: No.

7 MR. SAYRE: As is.

8 DR. BURDETTE: Why do you have to prescribe
9 that if the Legislature can raise salaries for the
10 next Legislature? It goes without saying.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me ask this first. When
12 the Committee says the Legislature may prescribe an
13 increase in salaries, do they mean only beyond the
14 elected term of the members of the Legislature.

15 DR. BARD: That is correct.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: So that you would be talking
17 about a constitutional provision adopted in 1967 that
18 would continue for perhaps, adopted by the people in
19 '68, continue for two more years.

20 MR. SAYRE: More than that.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: Assuming the Legislature --

DR. BARD: Two more, that is correct.
