term expire at the general election, and you would then have no person occupying that position from the time of the general election until the next session of the Legislature.

In other words, from November 7 until the third Monday of the next January, so perhaps this ought to say that the person so appointed shall serve until the next session of the Legislature immediately following the next biennial general election or some such language.

DR. JENKINS: Mr. Chairman, may I suggest if this gets too complicated, we may want to go back to, as provided by law. I suggest that to the Committee.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment as to Section 10? If not, we will move on, and go back to the body of your Report.

DR. BARD: Section 11, Page 4, you remember you had asked us to revise this in order to take care of certain situations where a person might have an opportunity to run for newly created positions or where a person might take over a position where the salaries had been increased but not increased by the General Assembly.
