DR. MICHENER: I had this in mind, and this is, of course, true in the Federal System where the request for documents has to be pertinent in some matter where Congress can legislate. But the State can legislate in any area, and my feeling was this restriction would not have meaning.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe?

MRS. BOTHE: Has there been any evidence that without the power, and I understand the General Assembly except by grand inquest has not had the power in all these years, it has been laboring under such a disability that they ought to be granted it with all the treachery and all the dangers inherent in it.
