THE CHAIRMAN: Well, are you suggesting that the Committee consider this Section as referred back to it for further wording? DR. BARD: For rewording. We tried very hard

to come to grips with how could we give them this power, but limit it so it would be germane; so it would be necessary and at the same time safeguard it. This we are seeking to do. Now, if we reword it, I would be certainly grateful to anyone on the Commission if they could come up with some wording perhaps during the three days we are here.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any objection to that procedure? JUDGE ADKINS: Does that carry with it a tacit acceptance of the power to compel, the subpoena power? In other words, is that question being foreclosed by this reference back; if so, I would like to have a vote on

THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think it is foreclosed. DR. BARD: No, let me say again, Judge Adkins, a while ago you said you felt that it ought to be there if two-thirds of the State Legislature would grant it.
