MR. BUND: I second the whole motion.

It might be better to separate THE CHAIRMAN: it, Mr. Case.

> MR. CASE: I move that it be reconsidered.

THE CHAIFMAN: Any further discussion, only on the question of reconsideration.

I think Mr. Case's motion is based MR. HOFF: upon the premise that the Legislative Council now has the power of subpoena. I don't think it has. I have served on the Legislative Council, and I have never heard of a subpoena being issued.

I have never heard of it being JIDGE ADKINS: issued by the Legislature or the Legislative Council.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Miller?

MR. MILLER: It seems to me, Mr. Chairman, that we can put something about this in the Constitution, if we do that, we are going into an awful lot of detail. It can be presumed that the legislative body is responsible and will not delegate authority to committees to just make a shotgun approach to any of these things, but
