1 listening to the debate and having my good friend, Stan Hoff, say the Legislative Council doesn't have 2 the power, and I am pretty sure I have read in the statutes 3 4 that it does have the power, I think that this discussion would be much more meaningful if each of us had an oppo-5 tunity to read and study a research memorandum that the 6 Commission's staff would make. I am therefore strongly 7 urging that before we try to vote on something that some 8 of us at least are confused about, and I will certainly 9 say that I am, that we have that opportunity; and there-10 fore I would like to make a motion in substitution 11 12 for the one that is before the Commission, and that is that this matter be re-referred to the Committee with 13 appropriate instructions that its research staff bring us 14 back a meaningful document from which we can base a 15 16 judgment. MR. CLAGETT: I would second that. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Hoff, will you second the 18 19 amendment? MR. HOFF: No, sir, I will not, but I will 20

second if the motion is defeated.

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
