have the same disorderly conduct. Now, two, you are dected, but you are underage. The people put you back in. Well, I guess that is a constitutional question.

THE CHAIRMAN: I take it from the way the language is drafted, the Committee intends to confer on the Legislature the power to expel a Member at any time for any reason by two-thirds vote.

MR. SAYRE: What about double jeopardy?

THE CHAIRMAN: At any time for any reason.

MR. SAYRE: The position of double jeopardy

is waived in here.

MR. GENTRY: That is criminal.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is not applicable here.

MR. SAYRE: If that is clear.

THE CHAIRMAN: I would think so. It seems to me it is clear when it says that two-thirds of all the Members may expel another Member without limitation.

It is not a punishment. It is simply an expulsion.

JUDGE ADKINS: May I ask what the word, punishment, means in this context?

THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?
