tion, I guess, would come under Section 15. All right, 1 how about people who eattend a session of the Legislature? 2 3 Under what? THE CHAIRMAN: I am sorry I can't hear you. 4 MR. SAYRE: Under what conditions can the body 5 6 exclude public attendance? THE CHAIRMAN: I am not sure I understand your 7 8 question. DR. BARD: Under what conditions might they 9 have so-called executive sessions, I am assuming. 10 11 Wouldn't that be under their rules? 12 DR. WINSLOW: Yes. 13 MR. DELLA: Yes. We feel that ought not to be in 14 DR. BARD: 15 the Constitution. MR. SAYRE: In other words, they could change 16 their rules in a certain period of time to exclude public 17 18 attendance. 19 THE CHAIRMAN: Apparently so. DR.
