1	moral reprimand.
2	On Page 22, Section 26, Article III, would
3	mean that no Governor of Maryland could be removed from
4	office by impeachment.
5	THE CHAIRMAN: I wouldn't agree with that con-
6	clusion.
7	DR. BURDETTE: He could be impeached, convicted
8	but that is only a moral reprimand.
9	THE CHAIRMAN: It seems to me the discussion
10	points up there is a diversion of views as to the word,
11	impeachment. Can the Committee clarify it?
12	MR. SAYRE: I am thinking of some language
13	that could be tacked on here for the penalty to be pro-
14	vided by law.
15	DR. BURDETTE: He could be removed from office.
16	MR. SAYRE: Yes. I like this language this
17	is closer to the existing Constitution, and if it is
18	appropriate, I would move to substitute the Section that
19	reads, the Governor, the heads of the principal depart-
20	ments the judicial officers and such other officers of

the State as may be designated by law are subject to im-

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
