peachment. Impeachment must originate in the House of Delegates and must be approved by a two-thirds vote of all the delegates. The Senate shall by law provide procedures for trial of impeachment and for removal from office of officers convicted. The Senate shall try all impeachment, and no person shall be convicted without the concurrence of two-thirds of all the senators.

That is in the present Constitution, and it has been very meaningful as in the case of Andrew Johnson, a great many people wouldn't vote for the conviction on political grounds because they were under oath, and it becomes a matter of religion.
