

1 the man for it. You can only remove the man from office  
2 and nothing more.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: No, you can do more because  
4 under the Federal Constitution, you can disjoin him from  
5 holding any office for profit, trust or honor in the  
6 United States.

7 DR. FICHENER: You can't execute the man. You  
8 have to have a separate trial for that.

9 MR. CASE: If you execute him, you don't need  
10 to do anything about it.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Are you ready for the question?

12 JUDGE ADKINS: What is the question?

13 THE CHAIRMAN: The question arises on Mr. Clag-  
14 et's motion to amend Mr. Sykes' motion to put in the last  
15 sentence the requirement that the Senate in trying an  
16 impeachment shall act under oath.

17 DR. BARD: Was there a second?

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, Dr. Burdette.

19 DR. BURDETTE: Why not use the language in  
20 the Constitution now? The present Constitution says,  
21 shall be on oath or affirmation to do justice according
