a Section in this Article that denies the power of the Legislature to enact local legislation except as provided under the Article.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think we better defer that until we consider the Report of the Committee on Local Legislation if we can.

MR. SAYRE: It was just sort of hanging. We can't do anything about it. But it would be an additional sector.

THE CHAIRMAN: I would like to start now with the consideration of the Report of the Committee on the Executive Department. If you can make your general comments, Judge Adkins, we can be thinking about it during dinner.

JUDGE ADKINS: There are two very relatively simply problems dealt with in this Report. The first is a succession to the office of governor, in the event the office should become vacant, and the second question is the government's veto power. Generally speaking, the succession to office provided is from the governor to the licutemant governor. In the absence of both of those
