last words, the office of the governor can be vacant.

JUDGE ADKINS: There is a later provision that provides for the filling of a vacancy. There are two concepts, one for the acting governor and one for the acting governor to succeed when the vacancy may occur prior to the time the governor is actually sworn into office.

THE CHAIRMAN: Anything further, comment or question? If not, we move on to Section (b) on Page 2.

JUDGE ADKINS: That Section deals with the amount of disability.

If the governor notifies the lieutenant governor in writing that he will be temporarily unable to carry out the duties of his office or if the governor is disabled and thereby unable to communicate such inability to the lieutenant governor, the lieutenant governor shall serve as acting governor in writing that he is able to carry out the duties of his office. If the governor does not notify the lieutenant governor in writing that he is able to carry out the duties of his office within six months from the time the lieutenant governor begins serving as acting governor, the office of governor shall be
