Legislature acted and in that event, it would be.

There is a proviso in there. DR. MICHENER:

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question? Section 2.

JUDGE ADKINS: The General Assembly may by a two-thirds vote of all members in joint session pass a declaration stating that the governor is unable to carry out the duties of his office by reason of a disability, including, but not limited to, physical or mental disbility. If the General Assembly passes such a declaration, it shall be delivered to the Court of Appeals, that will. of course, become the Supreme Court, which shall have original, exclusive and final jurisdiction to determine whether the governor is unable to discharge the duties of his office by reason of such disability. If the Court of Appeals determines that the governor is unable to discharge the duties of his office by reason of a disability, the
