could assume the office of governor without a written statement of the governor would be whereby the governor was in a coma. If the lieutenant governor attempted to assume the office when the governor was still on his feet, the governor could just give him the written notice indicating he was still serving as governor, and the lieutenant governor would have no power to call the Legislature into session. DR. BURDETTE: I don't think that would be very bad. I seem to recall that we are DR. JENKINS: going to have a provision whereby the General Assembly may convene itself without the call of the governor. THE CHAIRMAN: I thought we had done that, but I just checked with Mr. Brooks , and he told us we voted it down. We will have to stop now because we must maintain a schedule. Dinner will be probably at 6. 18 (Whereupon the Commission adjourned, to re-19 convene following dinner.) 20 21
