

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Clagett, you have to ask  
2 the question first: What has the Legislature provided  
3 by law?

4 MR. CLAGETT: The Legislature then more or  
5 less, accepting that as the question, jumping to the  
6 answer, the Legislature could do as it sees fit provided  
7 it did not exceed a total number of 70 days.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: No limit here?

9 DR. BARD: No limit. Unless they chose to  
10 draw as a limit and set different possibilities of  
11 extending it. That would be within their sphere of  
12 possibility.

13 JUDGE ADKINS: What does the term provided  
14 by law mean in this context?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: As we are using this phrase  
16 generally in the whole constitution we mean as provided  
17 by a statute adopted by the Legislature.

18 JUDGE ADKINS: It would have to concur in  
19 the length of the session of the legislative period  
20 adopted by the Legislature.
