there is a follow-up to our recommendation with this statement "It may be convened at other times by the Governor or at the written request of a majority of the members by the presiding officer of the Legislature."

This is a recommendation which the model makes that it be written into the constitution itself.

I would say were we to favor placing this statement in the constitution, we could then add a back-up statement such as this one or not add it. Two different points here.

from this recommendation that you were contemplating that the Legislature would have the full power to prescribe all details as to the sessions subject to all the limitations that it either be approved by the Governor or passed over his veto, that it be subject to referendum, everything else.

DR. BARD: That is correct.

part. I would like to avoid a situation whereby a legislature, let's say, hostile to the Governor politically
