you wanted to, so you have to go back the usual way, and it is just not an emergency so what is an emergency, and what isn't an emergency as far as borrowing is concerned does bring forth and can bring forth various shades of views, but whether it is or isn't, it is covered again by the first sentence, which deals in a general way with all types of borrowing.

Continuing, Section 31: The General Assembly may contract debts any amount that may be necessary for the defense of the State, again covered by Lines 1 and 2 of the proposed draft. As you can see, as we go through this, Lines 1 and 2 take care of about 16 lines of the present Constitution, and although again I reiterate I hate to see such apparently plain sort of words, do all this work, and take the place of something that has been with us for a long time, I must confess that I think it is the proper thing to do in this case.

Now, continuing, And provided further that nothing in this Section shall be construed to prohibit the raising of funds for the providing of aiding or compensating in such manner or in such way as the General Assembly of
