MR. SAYRE: Exactly, that very language I would like to see in.

I would accept that amendment and DR . BARD: I think our Committee members would because we discussed Am I right about that?

There is MR. MILLER: I think you are, sir. Particularly if one point that just occurred to me. we have -- the Committee's recommendation on staggered terms has been voted down -- it seems to me we ought to have some constitutional date in which a new Legislature would be compelled to meet. You can almost imagine a situation where if everybody was defeated in a landslide in November they would have a meeting in December and provide by law that the next Legislature shouldn't meet until the following November or something. I think it would be desirable to have something on the constitution that started off its new session because theoretically you might not have a single member holding over after four years.

I believe our Committee wants the Legislature once in the saddle to be able to run its own program.
