MR. SAYRE: I think I would favor a provision that would stipulate that they will be meeting once a year and one would be to convene each year on the first Wednesday after the first Tuesday in January.

MR. MILES: Without limitation on the number of days.

MR. SAYRE: That is right.

THE CHATRMAN: I sense there are at least three or four different propositions that are floating around in this discussion. I wonder if it wouldn't be better to take each one up separately to see if we can get a consensus. First take the recommendation as written now which means that the entire matter of when the Legislature should meet and how long it should sit and how it should be called is left entirely to be provided by law. That is, by statute subject to Gubernatorial approval or action over his veto and subject to referendum, in every respect except there should be at least one annual session. The first question is on that issue as coposed by the report.
