any place there; limiting any loan or extension of State 1 credit to a period of not exceeding. That would be right. 2 . MR. SYKES: Not exceeding? 3 THE CHAIRMAN: You don't want, it, o-f? 4 MR. CASE: Of not exceeding. 5 THE CHAIRIAN: To a period not exceeding? 6 7 MR. CASE: Period of not exceeding. THE CHAIRMAN: The point is, you don't need it, 8 It should be period, not exceeding. You don't need 9 10 the word, o-f. 11 'MR. CASE: Okay. Very well. That is right, 12 Melvin. MR. SYKES: The other question I was going to 13 ask was whether anyone, and if so who, is going to deal 14 with the question of whether there should be analogous 15 16 limitations on municipalities? THE CHAIRMAN: The Committee on Local Subdivisions 17 Political Subdivisions, Mr. Clagett's Committee. 18 MR. SYKES: I didn't see it expressly dealt with 19 20 in the draft. 21 THE CHAIRMAN: It hasn't been as yet.
