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is the lending of credit under this provision is acceptable to the marketplace to the same extent as the creation of an indebtedness of the State insofar as the attachment of value to endorsement is concerned?

MR. CASE: It is considered valuable, yes.

JUDGE ADKINS: Is it as valuable?

MR. CASE: It certainly is, yes. The answer to that in short is Yes. It is considered as valuable.

JUDGE ADKINS: So you don't feel it is neces-

MR. CASE: No.

sary to go any farther here?

JUDGE ADKINS: In providing for alternate methods of collection in order to get the best possible acceptance in the marketplace, as you have done with your insertion of your provision relative to the Controller

MR. CASE: No.

JUDGE ADKINS: You don't feel some alternate method of payment is necessary in the absence of subsequent acts by the Legislature in the event of default on the obligation?
